

As part of our yearly PTA events calendar we arrange two adventure trails; Halloween and Easter. The trails are aimed to be a safe family activity for those not wanting to go Trick or Treating at Halloween, or want to replace an Easter Egg hunt in the spring.

These are self led trails where families follow a mapped route (no more than 1 mile) with a clue sheet, spotting posters around the route. You then return to school where in exchange for a completed clue sheet, your child gets a prize.

You stay with your child, it is not a 'drop them off' event. Show your ticket at school and get a clue sheet. One Ticket per child. Adults are free.

Its always a circular route, starting and ending at Hatchlands Primary School.

The route is accessible for wheelchairs and buggies, on pavements with as few road crossings as possible.

They take place within daylight hours.

Refreshments and facilities are available at the school.

In order to get a prize, you must return your clue sheet, however we do always help with any missed clues in case you haven't found one or two!
